Admissions Policy

If we receive more applications for admission than we can cope with, places will be allocated according to the following guidelines laid down by the Local Authority.

- 1. Relevant Children in Care.
- 2. Students living within the catchment area of the school.
- 3. Students who would, in the first year to which the application relates, have an elder brother or sister in attendance at the school, who will still be attending at the proposed admission date.
- 4. Students who satisfy both of the following tests:
- a. they are distinguished from the great many of other applicants either on medical grounds which are supported by a medical report, obtained by parents, specifying the medical advantage of the child attending the preferred school compared with the normal catchment area school or by other exceptional circumstances material to the choice of school (i.e. the circumstances of the child, not the economic or social circumstances of the parent); and
 - b. they would suffer hardship if they were unable to attend the school.
- 5. Other students arranged in order of priority according to how near their home addresses are to the school, measurements being by the nearest practical walking route, and is determined by the use of a computerised system. Detailed below are summaries in respect of admissions to X School:
